INTERNATIONAL WORK PROJECTS

- ➊ **Mexico City, Mexico (Nov. 3-16 & 17-30, 2007)** - Two teams of 10-12 men to start construction of the Short Term Missions Centre at the Atizapan Church site.
- ➋ **Managua, Nicaragua (Jan 19 - Feb 2, 2008)** - Put second floor on Christian Education wing of church.
- ➌ **Guatemala, site yet to be confirmed (Feb 2-16, 2008)** - Project not yet confirmed.
- ➍ **Rio Chico, Mexico (Mar 1-15, 2008)** - Construct a second floor in new storehouse building at base camp.
- ➎ **Mexico City, Mexico (Mar 15-29, 2008)** - Install roof on Atizapan church.
- ➏ **Waveland, Mississippi** - Two years after the destruction of Hurricane Katrina an urgent need still exists. They are still in need of at least 1,000 volunteers over the next year to complete the job we started. They can accommodate 50 volunteers a day. They currently have 200 homes still needing repair, 200 families still needing help and hundreds more still waiting. Let's help our friends to finish well!
